<p>Team Leader</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identifies self as team leader • Assumes responsibilities for code/resuscitation upon arrival • Provides medical management of code • Directs competent delivery of NRP/PALS timely intubation, and administration of appropriate medications • Provides post code follow-up <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Continues care in the NICU ○ In event of death notifies attending LIP, completes documentation of death, donation, autopsy • Delegates dismissal of unneeded personnel • Communicates code progress to attending LIP 	<p>Neonatologist, Neonatal Nurse Practitioner or Pediatric Hospitalist</p>
<p>NICU Clinical Resource Specialist/Resuscitation Nurse</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assumes responsibilities of team leader until neonatologist/ NNP/ Ped Hospitalist arrives • Provides emergency care • Attaches cardio-respiratory monitor • Assists with respiratory support as needed • Establishes IV access • Administers medications as ordered • Assists team leader with procedures • Accompanies patient to NICU/ gives report to receiving RN • Restocks all equipment 	<p>NICU Clinical Resource Specialist, Resuscitation Nurse or KIDS Team member</p>
<p>Respiratory Therapy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Primary responsibility for airway management and blood gases • Ensures oxygen, suction, intubation and ventilation equipment are functioning • May assist with cardiac compressions 	<p>NICU Respiratory Therapist or KIDS Team RT</p>
<p>NICU Charge Nurse</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documents on the NICU /Code Record or ensures paper record scanned (if used) • Obtains equipment/supplies from emergency cart/emergency box • Draws and independently verifies medication doses and • Assists in set-up of sterile trays • Assures all participants are on record upon completion of code • Dismisses unneeded personnel • Coordinates family support • Assures donor request is completed if indicated 	<p>NICU Charge Nurse or designee</p>
<p>KIDS Team</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Responds as available • Back up intubation support • Assists with intubation, cardiac compressions, IV access, or medication administration as directed
